This program will develop leadership skills with a goal of accomplishing the following task: identify a problem in the community and create an extensive Leadership Action Plan which details a pathway for addressing that problem.

## Sample Schedule

The Ronald Reagan Student Leadership Program – Day Camp, is a five-day program, running Monday – Friday, 9:00 am – 3:30 pm. Students are required to attend all five days of their assigned session. Below are some activities that take place during the week.
